Legal foundation: Articles 38 ff of the University Ordinance UniV, 12.09.2012

Application and registration fee

- fee for application to studies	CHF	100
- Registration fee	CHF	100
- Fee for application after the regular application deadline	CHF	100

If your application leads to registration, your application fee also serves as your registration fee. An application fee can neither be refunded nor transferred to another semester.

Tuition fees

Tuition fee per semester CHF 750

- ^{1a*} Non-Swiss students pay an additional fee of CHF 200 per semester in addition to the tuition fee according to Section 1, if they did not have their civil law residence in Switzerland or the Principality of Liechtenstein at the time of achieving their university entrance qualification to a bachelor's degree program.
- ² Anyone who studies for more than twelve semesters without gaining a Diploma will pay CHF 1,500 in the first semester of the excess period. The fee will be doubled for each additional semester.
- ³ In cases of hardship, the University Board of Directors may waive all or part of the tuition fees shown under Section 2.
