Supporting documents to your online application

AFTER submission of the online application you will have to send the following documents by e-mail to the above-stated address.

- 1: Checklist; serves as cover sheet
- 2: Curriculum vitae in tabular form with uninterrupted chronology of your education and academic studies up to date incl. passport photo (45 mm high by 35 mm wide)
- 3: Motivation letter (maximum length one page)
- 4: Transcripts, covering all semesters of your Bachelor and, if applicable, Master study course; these documents must be stamped and signed by the faculty of your former university
- 5: Career plan

If necessary we will request additional documents.

¹ The Institute of Social Anthropology of the Faculty of Humanities evaluates your previous study record, assesses which courses at master or bachelor level you still need to attend before being admitted into the M A in Social and Cultural Anthropology CREOLE at the University of Bern and decides on what level you will be placed at and how many of your credits can be transferred. Basis of the recognition of your degree and study achievements are the documents submitted at the time of the request.
