2: Important information

Application

Hand in your application file as early as possible – ideally 4 months prior to the start of the degree course.

Supporting documents to your application

- All documents must be sent by letter post in one file. We do not review any electronic documents.
- Missing documents delay the application process.
- Your eligibility for admission will only be reviewed after receipt of all required documents, the application fee – and if need be – additional fee for a late application.

3: Language requirements

The main study language at bachelor level is German; exception: the language programs.

Some master programs are offered in English language. Other programs are mainly held in German.

Your language skills are not a criteria for admission as a visiting student.

The [German as a foreign language](#) unit provides German courses from levels A1 to C2 (beginners to advanced) for registered students.

4: Processing time

At least 3 weeks after receipt of the required documents.

5: How to complete the application form

Address data

All subsequent correspondence from the University of Bern will be sent to this address.

- **Phone number** and **e-mail** address have to be indicated.

Personal data

- **University matriculation number**

If you have already studied at another Swiss university, federal institute of technology, university of applied sciences or university of teacher education, the 8-digit matriculation number has to be stated. In this case, the number is on a label on the back side of your upper secondary school-leaving certificate or university degree.

- **AHV-Number** (old age and survivor's insurance number)

If you do not have one at the time of applying for admission, you may enter 000.0000.0000.00.
