## F. Other information

Medical insurance requirements	Students must have comprehensive international health insurance coverage throughout their stay. The insurance policy must include:  - Medical and health coverage  - Repatriation of remains  - Coverage for accidents and diseases (excluding preexisting conditions)  - Medical assistance during recovery/convalescence  - Psychological/mental health support  The policy should be valid for the entire duration of your stay in the country.
Cost of the stay	The estimated cost of living is between 500 and 700 US dollars a month. Additional costs should be taken into consideration for unexpected occurrences.
Accommodation	There are no residences provided by the university; therefore, students will have to look for their own accommodation.
Guidance and assistance	Each campus, provide assistance through their Academic Exchange Unit.
