How to finance your OA publication

Content

You submitted an article to a highly respected journal in your field and it has been accepted. Congratulations. Now all you have to do is transfer 3800 Euros to the publisher. No problem. You have heard that the SNSF pays these Article Processing Charges (APCs) or that there is a pot of money at the university from which such costs are covered; and then there are Read and Publish Agreements through which you can settle the APCs.

Are you sure? You may end up having to decide whether to pay for the article out of your own pocket or to withdraw it from this journal.

Make sure to clarify whether anyone (other than you) will pay for publication costs before submitting your article.
